Professional Development at Matipo School

This year, we are continuing our professional development journey with Whaea Josie from Te Kawerau ā Maki through the Mana Kura programme. Our focus is on deepening our staff's understanding of our tūpuna (ancestors) and our school pepeha. This learning will strengthen our ability to support our tamariki in connecting with their identity and sense of belonging.

We are also continuing with the Better Start Literacy Approach – Structured Literacy, as outlined by the Government. Our Year 4–6 teachers will begin their studies in Term 2, while most of our junior staff are already trained in this area. To further enhance our writing programme, we will continue working with Tools4Teachers to support professional development in this space.

In mathematics, we have started professional development in Numicon, utilizing resources provided by the Ministry to support and enhance our maths programme.

With a strong focus on learning and curriculum development, we are excited to begin implementing the refreshed New Zealand Curriculum this year. Lots of exciting mahi ahead!
